WHY VOTE FOR ME?

I have held the position of Chair for Unite's London & Eastern Region since our Union was formed in 2008 and before that held the same position in the TGWU. I am currently Vice President of the London, Eastern & South East TUC.

I have a wealth of experience in chairing large meetings, senior Committees and Conferences, ensuring fair debate and being part of a team that implements agreed policy.

At last year's conference I proposed motions on Grenfell and organised a fringe meeting on council housing. I have also recently convened a meeting to establish a labour movement coalition in London, to combat the rise of the far-right, believing that while we need to continue to work with broad antifascist organisations, our Party and our unions need to take the lead in taking on the dangerous narrative of populist racism and Islamophobia.

I have a sound understanding of our Party's structures and procedures.As Regional Chair and London Taxi Branch Secretary, I regularly lead meetings at local level and represent the Region at national level. I am a regular speaker at TUC and Labour Party Conferences and have chaired various fringe meetings.

I have represented my Union in negotiations with London Mayors, Government Ministers, Councillors, and TfL Commissioners and Directors on transport issues but also on broader issues of cuts to public services and the housing crisis.
