- To establish local networks through which Momentum members and supporters can build relationships with other trade unionists, receive advice and mentorship, support workplace struggles, and initiate recruitment and organising drives.
- To create a national network of rank-and-file trade unionists that can share information, experiences and tactics, across unions, sectors and regions.
- To deliver trade union education, working closely with trade unions to organise events and trainings aimed at increasing workplace organising skills and understandings of trade unionism, industrial politics and broader strategic analysis.
- To organise campaigns locally and nationally on issues such as fire and rehire or trade union rights.
