I am the founding CEO of the Sister's Forum, an East London wide BAME women's collective, working with local stakeholders, like trade unions to empower women in civic society, focusing on issues like Covid support and domestic violence. On a local civic level I have been a proactive member for the Independent Schools Panel on school Exclusions in Newham, which has given me a lot of experience of casework. I am also a governor of Little Ilford Secondary School.
