



Person specification for people to be considered by Momentum for the NEC.

Criteria
1. Demonstrable commitment to upholding and advancing Momentum's objectives, as outlined by the Constitution and interpreted by the NCG, and in particular the democratisation of the Labour Party and its transformation into a socialist, members-led party capable of harnessing the energy and talents of all its members and winning elections.
2. Experience of representing members and defending and advancing their concerns within Labour movement structures, including by contributing to discussions and decision-making on financial and organisational matters.
3. Strong understanding of Labour Party structures, including the rules, as well as informal conventions.
4. Demonstrable commitment to working and organising collectively, including by prioritising the objectives of Momentum and the Labour left.
5. Experience of developing positive and robust working relationships with diverse Labour movement stakeholders, including trade unionists, party staffers, and other elected representatives.
6. Track record of working to tight deadlines and managing multiple, competing priorities.
7. Ability to analyse the political landscape and make strategic assessments about which issues to prioritise.
8. Excellent interpersonal skills, including the ability to win people over with persuasion, manage conflict and build positive and robust working relationships with people at all levels of the Labour movement.
9. Excellent oral and reading skills, including the ability to synthesise extensive documents on short timescales.
10. Ability to exercise a high level of discretion, diplomacy, and judgment in sensitive political situations.
11. Integrity and sensitivity to ethical and equalities issues and a strong commitment to equal opportunity in all matters.
12. Ability and willingness to attend all NEC meetings and related activities.
13. Ability to win the support of the key voter groups required to get elected.
